

REGULATION OF THE STATISTICS INDONESIA
NUMBER 10 OF 2023

ON
STATISTICAL DATA STANDARDS

BY THE GRACE OF ALMIGHTY GOD

CHIEF STATISTICIAN OF STATISTICS INDONESIA,

Considering : a. that in organizing statistical activities within the national statistical system, it is necessary to formulate statistical data standards applicable across central and/or regional government institutions;
b. that to adapt statistical data standards to developments in statistical administration, it is necessary to replace Regulation of the BPS-Statistics Indonesia Number 4 of 2021 concerning National Statistical Data Standards;

In view of : 1. Law Number 16 of 1997 concerning Statistics (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Year 1997 Number 39, Supplement to the State Gazette Number 3683);
2. Presidential Regulation Number 86 of 2007 concerning the BPS-Statistics Indonesia (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Year 2007 Number 139);
3. Regulation of the BPS-Statistics Indonesia Number 7 of 2020 concerning the Organization and Work Procedures of the BPS-Statistics Indonesia (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Year 2020 Number 1585);
4. Regulation of the BPS-Statistics Indonesia Number 5 of 2023 concerning the Organization and Work Procedures of Provincial and District/Municipal Statistics Agencies (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Year 2023 Number 429);

HAS DECIDED:

To stipulate : THE REGULATION OF THE STATISTICS INDONESIA CONCERNING STATISTICAL DATA STANDARDS.

Article 1

In this Agency Regulation, the following terms are defined as:

1. Statistical Data means numerical data describing characteristics or specific features of a population

obtained through collection, processing, presentation, and analysis.

2. Statistical Data Standards, hereinafter referred to as SDS, are standardized concepts, definitions, classifications, measurements, and units used to produce standardized statistical data.
3. Agency refers to the Central Statistics Agency.
4. State Administration Institutions, hereinafter referred to as Institutions, are legislative, executive, and judicial institutions at both the central and regional levels, and other institutions established by statutory regulations.
5. National Statistical System refers to a structured framework of interconnected components that collectively form the administration of statistics.

Article 2

SDS serves as a reference for Institutions in:

- a. providing standardized statistical data;
- b. fulfilling concepts, definitions, classifications, measurements, and units that facilitate data usability; and
- c. being one of the components for evaluating the maturity of statistical administration.

Article 3

- (1) SDS comprises:
 - a. concepts;
 - b. definitions;
 - c. classifications;
 - d. measurements; and
 - e. units.
- (2) SDS as referred to in paragraph (1) is identified based on the SDS code and/or data name.
- (3) SDS as referred to in paragraph (1), along with the SDS code and data name in paragraph (2), shall be determined by the Head of the Agency.

Article 4

- (1) The Concept as referred to in Article 3 paragraph (1) letter (a) is an idea or notion that forms the basis of data and further explains standardized Statistical Data.
- (2) The Concept as referred to in paragraph (1) is supplemented with a concept code.
- (3) The structure of the concept code as referred to in paragraph (2) is outlined in the Appendix, which is an integral part of this Agency Regulation.

Article 5

- (1) The Definition as referred to in Article 3 paragraph (1) letter (b) is an explanation of the data name that clearly delineates or differentiates the meaning and scope of specific data from other data.
- (2) The Definition must be prepared based on valid and credible references.

- (3) Valid and credible references as referred to in paragraph (2) may be sourced from:
 - a. statutory regulations;
 - b. international standards;
 - c. literature or scientific journals; and/or
 - d. agreements among Institutions.

Article 6

- (1) The Classification as referred to in Article 3 paragraph (1) letter (c) is the systematic grouping of data into groups or categories based on criteria established by the Agency or widely standardized.
- (2) Data classification consists of:
 - a. Classification of entries; or
 - b. Classification of presentation.
- (3) Classification of entries as referred to in paragraph (2) letter (a) is used for categorical data.
- (4) Classification of presentation as referred to in paragraph (2) letter (b) is used for numerical data.

Article 7

The Measurement as referred to in Article 3 paragraph (1) letter (d) is the unit used to measure the quantity, magnitude, or scope of data.

Article 8

The Unit as referred to in Article 3 paragraph (1) letter (e) is a specific value in the data that is used as a standard for measuring or assessing a whole.

Article 9

- (1) The SDS Code as referred to in Article 3 paragraph (2) aims to:
 - a. provide a unique identity for the SDS; and
 - b. facilitate the interoperability of data systems using SDS as a reference.
- (2) The structure of the SDS Code as referred to in paragraph (1) is outlined in the Appendix, which is an integral part of this Agency Regulation.

Article 10

- (1) The Data Name as referred to in Article 3 paragraph (2) describes the type of standardized Statistical Data.
- (2) The types of standardized Statistical Data as referred to in paragraph (1) include:
 - a. Numerical data; or
 - b. Categorical data.
- (3) Numerical data as referred to in paragraph (2) letter (a) refers to quantitative data expressed as numbers or figures that can be processed using mathematical operations.
- (4) Categorical data as referred to in paragraph (2) letter (b) refers to qualitative data that can be grouped into categories and identified based on labels.

Article 11

Upon the enactment of this Regulation, Regulation of the BPS-Statistics Indonesia Number 4 of 2021 concerning National Statistical Data Standards (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Year 2021 Number 1288) is hereby revoked and declared no longer valid.

Article 12

This Regulation shall come into force on the date of its promulgation

To ensure public awareness, this Regulation shall be promulgated by its placement in the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia.
