

REGULATION OF THE CHIEF STATISTICIAN  
NUMBER 7 OF 2013  
ON  
THE CODE OF ETHICS FOR EMPLOYEES WITHIN  
THE BPS-STATISTICS INDONESIA

BY THE GRACE OF ALMIGHTY GOD

THE CHIEF STATISTICIAN,

Considering : That in implementing the provisions of Article 13 paragraph (1) letter a of Government Regulation Number 42 of 2004 concerning the Development of Corps Spirit and Code of Ethics for Civil Servants, it is deemed necessary to stipulate Regulation of The Chief Statistician concerning The Code of Ethics for Employees within the BPS-Statistics Indonesia (BPS);

Referring to : 1. Law Number 8 of 1974 on Civil Service Principles (State Gazette of 1974 Number 55, Supplement to the State Gazette Number 3041), as amended by Law Number 43 of 1999 (State Gazette of 1999 Number 169, Supplement to the State Gazette Number 3890);

2. Law Number 28 of 1999 on State Administration Free from Corruption, Collusion, and Nepotism (State Gazette of 1999 Number 75, Supplement to the State Gazette Number 3851);

3. Government Regulation Number 42 of 2004 on the Development of Corps Spirit and Code of Ethics for Civil Servants (State Gazette of 2004 Number 142, Supplement to the State Gazette Number 4450);

4. Government Regulation Number 53 of 2010 on Discipline of Civil Servants (State Gazette of 2010 Number 74, Supplement to the State Gazette Number 5135);

5. Presidential Decree Number 163 of 1998 on the College of Statistical Sciences;

6. Presidential Regulation Number 86 of 2007 on the BPS-Statistics Indonesia;

7. Various organizational regulations of the BPS-Statistics Indonesia;

DECIDES:

To enact : REGULATION OF THE CHIEF STATISTICIAN ON THE CODE OF ETHICS FOR EMPLOYEES WITHIN THE BPS-STATISTICS INDONESIA.

## CHAPTER I GENERAL PROVISIONS

### Article 1

In this regulation, the following terms are defined as:

1. Employees refer to Civil Servants and Civil Servant Candidates serving at BPS.
2. BPS refers to the Central Statistics Agency.
3. Code of Ethics refers to guidelines for conduct, behavior, and actions of employees.
4. Violation of the Code of Ethics refers to any actions, words, or writings that conflict with the Code of Ethics.
5. Ethics Council refers to the council formed to determine any employee's violation of the Code of Ethics.

## CHAPTER II PURPOSE

### Article 2

The Code of Ethics aims to:

- a. maintain the dignity, honor, and credibility of BPS;
- b. avoid conflicts of interest; and
- c. realize the vision and mission of BPS.

## CHAPTER III CORE VALUES

### Article 3

Core values to be upheld by every employee include:

- a. professionalism;
- b. integrity; and
- c. accountability.

CHAPTER IV  
THE CODE OF ETHICS

Article 5

The Code of Ethics for Employees includes:

- a. loyalty to BPS above personal or group interests;
- b. avoiding misuse of BPS for personal gain;
- c. maintaining neutrality and rejecting unethical directives;
- d. keeping statistical data confidential;
- e. providing excellent and impartial services;
- f. ensuring accountability in the use of state finances and assets;
- g. upholding BPS's integrity and public trust.

CHAPTER V  
ETHICS COUNCIL

Article 6

1. An Ethics Council will be established to address alleged violations.
2. Membership includes a Chair, Secretary, and at least three members.
3. Decisions will be based on hearings, and sanctions will be applied if violations are proven.

CHAPTER VI  
SANCTIONS

Article 10

Employees proven to violate the Code of Ethics may receive:

1. Moral Sanctions: Issued privately or publicly, depending on the severity of the violation.
2. Administrative Actions: In accordance with civil service disciplinary regulations.

CHAPTER VII  
REHABILITATION

Article 13

Employees found not guilty will have their reputations restored.

CHAPTER VIII  
CLOSING PROVISIONS

Article 14

This regulation comes into effect on the date of promulgation.
