

REGULATION OF THE BPS-STATISTICS INDONESIA
NUMBER 5 OF 2020
ON
TECHNICAL GUIDELINES FOR STATISTICAL METADATA

THE CHIEF STATISTICIAN,

Considering : That in order to provide technical guidelines for the management of statistical metadata for central and/or regional institutions, and to support the national statistical system and the Satu Data Indonesia initiative, it is necessary to establish the Regulation of the BPS-Statistics Indonesia concerning Technical Guidelines for Statistical Metadata;

Referring to : 1. Law Number 16 of 1997 on Statistics (State Gazette of 1997 Number 39, Supplement to the State Gazette Number 3683);
2. Presidential Regulation Number 86 of 2007 on the BPS-Statistics Indonesia (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Year 2007 Number 139);
3. Presidential Regulation Number 39 of 2019 on Satu Data Indonesia (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Year 2019 Number 112);
4. Regulation of the Chief Statistician of the BPS-Statistics Indonesia Number 7 of 2008 on the Organization and Work Procedures of the Central Statistics Agency, as last amended by Regulation of the Head of the BPS-Statistics Indonesia Number 9 of 2017 (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Year 2017 Number 107);

DECIDES:

To enact : REGULATION OF THE BPS-STATISTICS INDONESIA ON TECHNICAL GUIDELINES FOR STATISTICAL METADATA.

Article 1

In this Agency Regulation, the following terms are defined as:

1. Metadata refers to structured and standardized information used to describe data, explain data, and facilitate the search, use, and management of data.
2. Statistical Activity Metadata refers to a collection of information attributes that provide documentation on the implementation of statistical activities.
3. Variable Metadata refers to a collection of information attributes that provide documentation for the development of a variable, including standards for measurement, units used, rules for completion, and question forms applied.

4. Indicator Metadata refers to a collection of information attributes that provide documentation for the formation of an indicator, to ensure proper understanding and application of the indicator. Statistical Data means numerical data describing characteristics or specific features of a population obtained through collection, processing, presentation, and analysis.
5. Statistics refers to data obtained through the processes of collection, processing, presentation, and analysis, as well as the systems regulating these processes.

Article 2

- (1) The standardized structure and format for Statistical Metadata applicable across central and/or regional institutions are determined by the Chief Statistician of the BPS-Statistics Indonesia.
- (2) Ministries or heads of Central Institutions may determine standardized structures and formats for data intended to fulfil institutional needs, provided they align with the standardized structure and format determined by the Chief Statistician of the BPS-Statistics Indonesia.
- (3) To carry out statistical metadata development, the Chief Statistician of the BPS-Statistics Indonesia may form a Statistical Metadata Team.

Article 3

The technical guidelines for Statistical Metadata are contained in the Annex, which forms an integral part of this Agency Regulation.

Article 4

This Agency Regulation comes into effect on the date of its promulgation.

To ensure public awareness, it is ordered that this Regulation be promulgated in the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia.
